Business Checklist

■ Business License

All persons conducting a business in Pinole are required to have a City of Pinole business license.

T Fictitious Business Name

All businesses must file a Fictitious Name Statement to check the name of the business.

□ Sales & Use Seller's Permit

If you sell tangible property in California, you must apply for a Seller's Permit.

T Environmental Health Permit

A health permit is required for businesses that dispense food to the public. Permit is needed before opening or being issued a business license.

☐ Fire Inspection

Required of the business location.

☐ State Contractor's License

☐ Alcohol Beverage License

You must apply if you plan to sell or serve alcoholic beverages at your business.

T CA Franchise Tax Board

All businesses in CA are required to submit an annual tax statement to the Franchise Tax Board.

☐ Internal Revenue Service

For information regarding employee federal withholdings, selfemployment tax, sole proprietorship, partnership and corporate taxes.

■ Workers' Compensation

State legislation requires proof of valid current workers' compensation certificate of insurance or self-insurance. Not required if you do not have employees.

☐ Employer Registration

If you hire employees, you must register with the State Employment Development Department within 15 days after employees are hired.

Unincorporated Area Taxes

Inquire about information regarding other services and resources, including FREE Small Business Workshops, the Business Development Center, the Small Business Administration and the Pinole Redevelopment Agency
